The Pollution Prevention Award was presented to **Transit Middle School** this year for their slogan of "Safe, Stable, Sustainable and Stunning" which was truly exemplified with their presentation, model and display board. - \* They used recycled corn husks for concrete;

- \* Their project used a plasma gasification process for handling solid waste, with the waste slag used for building materials, with organic composting and the syn-gas for energy and
